## HOW IT WORKS: BROADCAST DNS

Broadcast DNS is a stationlist included in Journaline 2.0. It helps receivers keep the stationlist updated, without the need for a rescan.

GPS coördinates are used to identify the receiver area. All channels in the list have a position reference.

In each ensemble, a list of its own channels is listed with updated information.

In addition, a list of other frequencies in the area and in neighbouring areas is listed. Neighbouring areas might have different local stations.

The Broadcast DNS-list should be normalized with the government and always be up to date with current permissions.
